The Conservatory Year

The Conservatory school year is arranged in four 10-week quarters from September through June. Our summer session is flexible in duration, which means you only pay for lessons on the weeks you are available. Tuition is prorated based upon your lesson start date. Students are billed individually according to pre-arranged schedules.

New Students: Payment is due in full upon registration.

Absences & Make-Up Lessons

- **A minimum notice of 2 hours is requested if a student will miss a lesson.** Students must call the Center to notify the instructor of their absence. **If the Center is not contacted, the absence will not be excused.**
- Two excused absences will be given per conservatory year (September through June). No excused absences or make-up lessons will be given during the flexible summer session.
 - One excused absence for the period covering 1st and 2nd Quarters
 - One excused absence for the period covering 3rd and 4th Quarters.
- 1st and 2nd Quarter excused absence make-up lessons will be scheduled with the instructor to take place during the dedicated make-up week following the end of the 2nd Quarter.
- 3rd and 4th Quarter excused absence make-up lessons will be scheduled with the instructor to take place during the flexible summer session.

- Excused absence make-up lessons will not be carried over. If a scheduled make-up lesson is missed, it will not be rescheduled. Credits will not be given in place of an excused absence make-up lesson.
- If lessons are cancelled due to teacher absence or inclement weather, a make-up lesson will be given or a credit will be applied toward the next quarter. No other credits or make-up lessons will be given or issued.
