

Counselor In Training (CIT) Info Sheet

Thank you for your interest in Perkins Center's **Counselor-In-Training (CIT)** Program. The CIT Program offers an opportunity for students to earn volunteer service hours while gaining leadership skills and learning to work with teaching faculty and young campers. Please take the time to review the time frame and description of volunteer expectations.

Perkins Center for the Arts Summer Camp

A full day Arts Camp for youth 5-14 years old. CITs will be assigned to groups of 5-11 year olds.

CIT Age Requirement: All applicants must be 14 years old by June 1st, 2018

Application Due: Monday, March 26th, 2018

Interview will be scheduled during the week of April 16th.

2018 Summer Camp Dates:

Session 1: June 25- July 6 (No Camp Wed, July 4th) Field Trip: June 29

Session 2: July 9- July 20 Field Trip: July 13

Session 3: July 23- August 3 Field Trip: July 27

Session 4: August 6 – August 17 Field Trip: August 10

Hours: Morning and Afternoon options: 8am-12pm; 9am-1pm; 12pm-4pm; or 1pm-5pm

M-F, 10 days per session (9 days for Session 1)

Note: Morning Shift CITs should plan to help during field trip days -6/29, 7/13, 7/27, and 8/10.

Afternoon shift CITs should plan to help with Final Friday clean-up on the following dates: 7/6, 7/20, 8/3, and 8/17.

Counselor-in-Training (CIT):

Supports the Camp Coordinator, Counselors, and Staff with the following duties:

- Supervision of campers throughout the duration of the day
 - Ex: extended care, drop-off, class-time, snack/activity time, lunch, pick-up, field trips, and Final Fridays
 - Help facilitate games and play during break times.
 - Encourage campers to join in activities and have fun.
- Assisting teaching-artist with class activates
 - Help set up and cleanup classrooms
 - Assist in distribution of supplies
 - Help campers when they need individual assistance (cutting, pottery, drawing, sewing, etc.)
- Contributing to the smooth operation of the camp day, lunches, field trips, and Final Fridays
- Attending a weekly camp briefing every Tuesday at 9:30am or 1:30pm (two times so that all CITS have an opportunity to be a part of the discussions)
- Please note, the use of phones, digital devices, gaming systems, and photo messaging apps is prohibited during camp and around campers.

Before you start:

- Interviews will be conducted on a rolling basis beginning in April
- A mandatory Camp Orientation Meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, June 13th at 4:00pm.

Compensation:

- CIT Program Completion Certificate; Volunteer/Community Service Hrs.
- 1 year Student Membership to Perkins Center
