Paul Cava – 2019 Juror

Paul Cava is a photo-based artist who is known for his sensual and emotionally driven collage work. Concentrating on the figure, Cava's work speaks to the most intrinsic of human concerns.

Paul Cava has exhibited paintings, drawings and photo-based works from 1976 to the present in galleries and museums in the United States and Europe, and his work has been collected by a broad range of private and public institutions, including The Museum of Fine Arts, Houston, The Philadelphia Museum of Art, The Princeton University Museum of Art, and The Bibliotheque Nationale, Paris.



His work has been featured in many publications including Eyemazing Magazine and Das Magazin. Cava was a recipient of Pennsylvania Council on the Arts grants in 1981 and 1999. In 2005, the German publisher Galerie Vevais, published *Walt Whitman / Paul Cava, Children of Adam from Leaves of Grass* — a bold union of Whitman's erotic poems and Cava's art work.

One photo in the exhibition will be selected by Peter Barberie, The Brodsky Curator of Photographs at The Philadelphia Museum of Art for their permanent collection. The maximum payment to the artist for the Purchase Award (funded by Perkins Center) is \$600.

PERKINS CURATOR AWARD

Three artists will be invited by Perkins Center's Curators for inclusion in a future exhibition at our Collingswood Gallery in 2020.

REQUIREMENTS

Artists are invited to submit a maximum of three works that have been created within the past three years. **The entry fee is \$15 per entry.** Works previously shown in a Perkins Center annual juried exhibition will not be accepted. **All artists must submit on our website under "Exhibitions" at www.perkinsarts.org.** Works will be hand delivered to the center listed under Delivery & Pickup dates to be juried.

FRAMING INFORMATION & INSTRUCTIONS

1. All entries must be framed and wired on back
2. It is strongly recommended that submitted works be:
 - a) Framed according to professional standards
 - b) Photographs should be covered with glass or Plexiglas
 - c) **Wired with picture framing wire only**
 - d) Works on paper larger than 24" x 36" (or 36" x 24") must be covered with Plexiglas, they will not be insured
 - e) Works printed on canvas are accepted

SIZE REQUIREMENTS

Maximum framed size: 50" x 50"
Maximum weight: 45 lbs.

THE FOLLOWING ARE NOT ACCEPTED

1. **2 pieces of glass** or Plexiglas joined together by clips
2. **Table Top Frames**
3. **Alligator clips**
4. Works with special hanging requirements should be discussed in advance with the curator: 856.235.6488x.202
