Homebound Folk Art Terms and Conditions

*** The “Folk Arts for Homebound” is an initiative which brings folk artists to homebound participants’ residences for entertainment and/or educational purposes. The durations and art forms will be determined by both participants and folk artists after a service assessment session conducted by staff at the regional folk arts center.**

The individual(s) and artists must agree to the following requirements or face termination of the program

- 1) Answer all personal inquiries accurately.
- 2) Notify staff at the Folk Art Center providing your program before terminating the service.
- 3) Notify staff of any related concerns, illness, or other issues that may affect planned program sessions.
- 4) Attend training session provided by staff (*artists only*).
- 5) Provide feedback by filling out a post program evaluation form and participating in follow up conversations with the Folk Art Center providing your program.
- 6) Indemnify and hold all parties harmless from any claims which may arise in the future as a result of said service.
- 7) Maintain confidentiality regarding personal contacts of participants and artists.
- 8) Ensure the presence of a family member or caregiver that can assist with any medical or personal needs of the participant during the program sessions.
- 9) Provide a safe and suitable place for program sessions to take place in your home.
